Student Drop off & Pick up

For the safety of students and staff we have set drop off and pick up procedures.

AM Drop off – Between the times of 7:30 and 7:50, Jr/Sr High Students will need to be dropped off in parking lot, away from car rider line, and walk across the lot. No students are to be dropped off at the entrances of the school during this time due to the elementary car rider line.



BACKGROUND

Some children may receive breakfast and lunch at no cost if they are eligible for free and reduced meals based on federal poverty guidelines. Sometimes, however, children who do not qualify for such programing may lack money in their cafeteria accounts. Meals are never denied to students, but the unpaid meal charges present a difficult and stressful issue for the students we serve.

THE SOLUTION

To assist with unpaid meal charges, the LCS Child Nutrition Department maintains a lunch assistance "angel" fund account. This account is directly funded by members of the community. With the help of the food services director, head cashier, school administrators, and counselors, these funds are distributed to students in need.
