Student Drop off & Pick up

For the safety of students and staff we have set drop off and pick up procedures.
AM Drop off – Between the times of 7:30 and 7:50, Jr/Sr High Students will need to be dropped off in parking lot, away from car rider line, and walk across the lot. No students are to be dropped off at the entrances of the school during this time due to the elementary car rider line.

If students arrive at school after 7:55 a.m., they are considered tardy and must sign in at the office.

PM Pick up – No students should be picked up at the front of the building during dismissal until the elementary car rider line has ended. After buses/car rider line drivers have left, students may be picked up at the school entrance.

One-year vaccine: \$15 -- Three year vaccine: \$25

Must bring proof of previous vaccination to get the 3-year shot.

Animals must be at least 12 weeks old to be vaccinated.

CASH ONLY PLEASE

All locations are in the parking lots.

Bring pets on a leash or in a carrier.

You do not have to be a Harrison County resident to attend.

Pregnant animals should not be vaccinated.

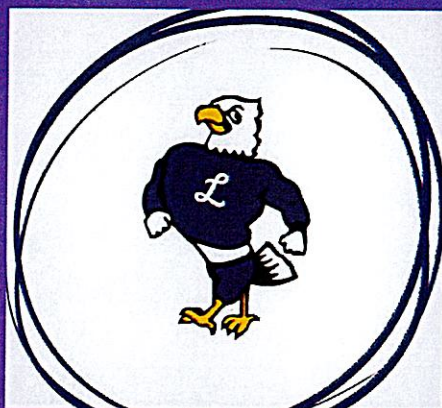
